

8th Grade Night Information

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Greetings! The 8th graders are gearing up for concert season, kicking it off with 8th Grade Night at the Youth Night Game on **Friday, October 11th 2019**.

On the 11th, the doors to the High School Band room will be open at 4:30. The attire is Alder spiritwear and jeans. Students are asked to wear closed-toed tennis shoes. Students are to drop off cases and then head to the High School Football Field. They must be on the field at 5pm. If they are not on the field with their instrument at this time, students will be considered late. After rehearsal students will head back to the high school and hang out while the High School Students get into uniforms.

They will parade down to the field with the High School at 6:30. The 8th grade performance will begin around 6:35/6:40pm. Once finished the students will move with the High School Band to the stands, where they will help cheer on the team for the remainder of the game. Our Boosters will be providing students with hotdogs, chips, and water. If your student would like anything additional, they are welcome to bring money for concessions.

Since this is a school sponsored event, students are held to the same guidelines as listed in the school and band handbooks. Any students found breaking any of the guidelines may be asked to leave the event and a separate consequence may ensue at the directors' discretion.

Football games are unpredictable, all times given are an approximation. Students will be given plenty of heads up in order to communicate if anything changes! We use the Remind App in order to keep parents informed of changes in schedule or return times. Attached to this packet is an instruction guide on how to sign up!

In order to prepare for this action packed Friday, we ask that 8th grade students be at the **rehearsal** on **Thursday, October 10th** with the High School Band. Rehearsal starts at 2:45pm and will end at 4:00pm. Students may either be shuttled on the bus from the Junior High to High School in order to participate or will need a ride from a parent/guardian! On the next page, is a bus slip giving students permission to ride the bus from the Junior High to High School. This form is due **Wednesday, October 9th**.
